3 on 3 Game Structures

- **Tuesday 9th July 2019**

- All games including Grand final to be played on Tuesday

PLAYERS

- All players CAN be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent, Non-Indigenous friends are encouraged to participate
- Teams at the tournament may have up to 2 non Aboriginal players; however no more than 1 non Aboriginal player may take the court at any one time.
- No players may take part or participate in more than one (1) age group.
- Mixed under 10 teams must consist of both genders. Eg. 2 boys-2 girls etc. **There must be 1 girl on the court at all times.**
- Each junior player must be under the age group as at the 31st December 2019
Eg. No player will be allowed to play in an age group if they are turning that age this year. To be eligible to play in under 12's
The player must be 10 or 11.
This applies to every age group.
- All players MUST have a completed consent form to play in basketball competition. See attached
- If nomination form hasn't been received by due date, junior players can be refused from entering the tournament

Proof of Age

Players are advised that they maybe asked to show proof of age.

A letter from the following will be accepted;

- Community Organization
- School
- Statutory Declaration etc.

AGE DIVISON ELIGIBILITY

Under 10 Mixed	Born 2010
Under 12	Born 2008
Under 14	Born 2006
Under 16	Born 2004
Under 18	Born 2002

CONDITIONS OF GAMES

- All matches shall commence at the advised time
- No teams shall take the court with less than 2 players
- A team unable to take the court within 4 minutes of game, team will have to forfeit the game. 1 point will be awarded to opposition team for every minute late.
- Send off rule:
First tech Foul – 2 min send off rule
Second tech Foul – disqualification for the rest of the game
Third tech Foul- disqualification for the rest of the tournament

UNIFORMS

Each team can supply their own uniform for the competition. If teams do not have any uniforms BWAYS will supply coloured bibs, please notify administration during registration.

- If teams uniform clash first team name in score sheet must wear coloured bibs

DISPUTE COMMITTEE

- The committee shall be made up of independent people who will address complaints.

- Complaints must be in writing & lodged 7 minutes after game/incident has finished.
- The coach or team managers are the only people who can lodge a complaint.

POINTS

Points shall be awarded on the following basis:

1. For a win 2 points
2. For a loss 0 points
3. For a forfeit 1 points
4. For a draw 1 point.

If any (2) or more teams have the same number of ladder points, point's places shall be determined by percentage between the tied teams.

OFFICIALS & BENCH DUTYS

It is compulsory for each team to provide the following officials duty is indicated for court officials.

- Coach / Team manager
- Scorer

It will be the referee's responsibility to complete and return score sheets to the Tournament office.

TIME KEEPING

- All games consist of two 7 minute halves (with a 1 minute half time break.)

The time frame may alter to suit the circumstances of the competition. The organisers reserve the right to alter the duration of games.

Grand Final

- There will be no semifinals. Top 2 placed sides will compete in the grand final.

Grand Finals shall consist of two 10 minute halves, with 2 time outs per half.

- Clock stops on time outs only 1 per team per half.
- 2 minute break for half time
- Extra period shall be of 5 minutes duration for drawn games in final series only.

Tie Break

- If the scores are level at full time in Grand Final, there will be a time on of 5 minutes.
- If scores are still level, an extra period of 5 minutes will be awarded until a winner is found. A jump ball will determine who has first possession of the ball in over time.

ELIGIBILITY FOR FINALS

A player to be eligible to play in the finals must have played two matches for his/her nominated team

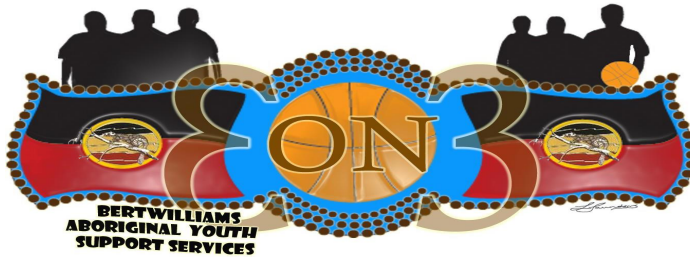
If divided into pools the two top teams from each section/division will enter into the finals for age group.

CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

We encourage all in a attendance to have a memorable time at this premier sporting event conducted by VACSAL and hosted by the Bert Williams Aboriginal Youth Services and remind you all of the importance of local protocols we ask you to respect.

The Tournament has a number of guiding principles we ask you to support:

- ❖ We remind you and ask that you acknowledge the traditional custodians.
- ❖ You **MUST** respect both Indigenous and Non-Indigenous community members. Therefore, we ask that you treat the visit, as you would wish your community be treated when communities come to your country.
- ❖ Ensure a safe and healthy environment for all families, in particular young children attending the carnival.
- ❖ Respect the Stadium and surrounding area, which includes all their Signage.
- ❖ Refrain from smoking in those areas where smoking is not permitted
- ❖ No Alcohol or Drugs are allowed at the 3 on 3 basketball competition
- ❖ Spectators are to respect the Referee's decision.
- ❖ Spectator's unsatisfactory behaviour may be asked to leave the stadium and Abide by Stadium Rule's.
- ❖ Player's are to respect opposition players.
- ❖ Encourage the feeling of goodwill and sportsmanship towards all members participating in the competition.

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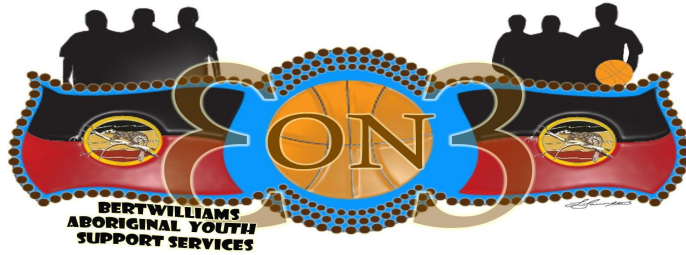
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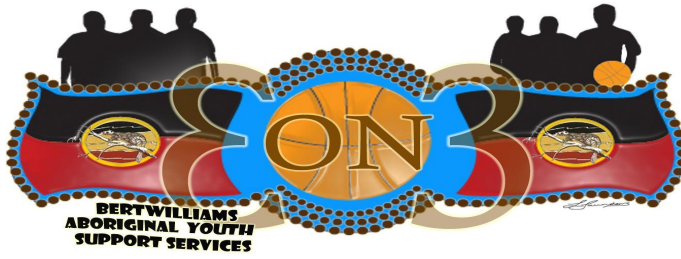
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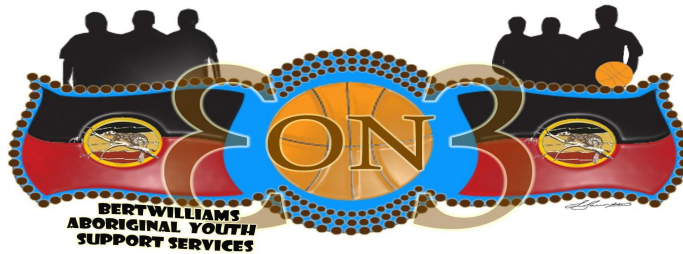
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
