



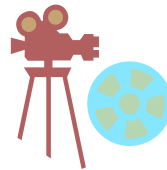

Three grants of \$1500 are available to individuals or groups to develop a project idea into a film, Ad or social media clip

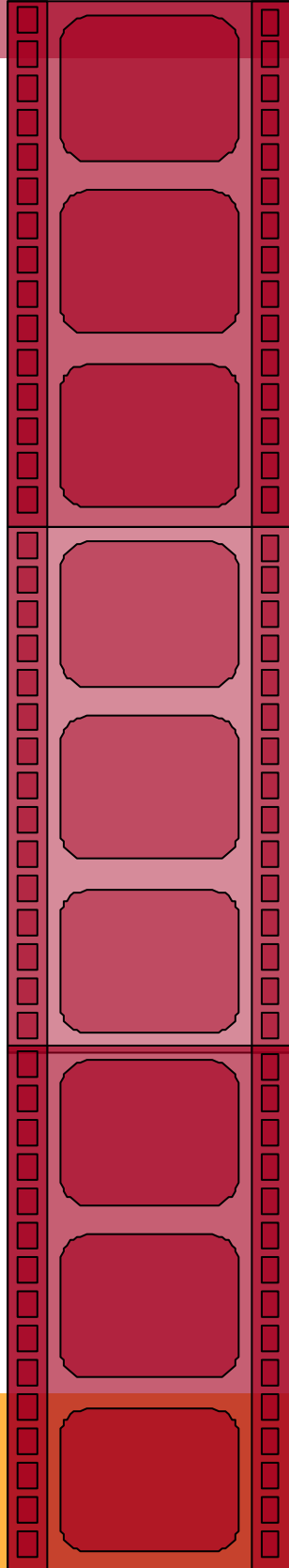

Expression of Interest Guidelines

What's this all about?

We invite Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who work, study or live in the local area of Banyule to develop a short film, Ad or social media clip that promotes community discussion about the influence of gambling on the Aboriginal Community's health, wellbeing and culture. We are looking for ideas that might reduce harm from gambling in our Community.

What's involved?

Interested Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Community Members can submit ideas to the Northern Aboriginal Gambling Issues Group (NAGIG). Three ideas will be selected and funded. If you are successful, you will have several months to complete the work.

What you need to know?

The \$1,500 will be paid on submission of work but advance payments may be possible to cover up front expenses

What we require from you Checklist:

Please attach any other supporting material that you think will assist with your selection

If you need help to fill out the Expression of Interest Form, you can discuss your idea directly with us and we will assist with completing the form.

Selection Criteria:

A panel of key partners and stakeholders will select three (3) entries to develop their clip or advertisements based on the following selection criteria:

1. Originality of concept ideas
2. Clarity of message
3. Experience of filmmaker/artist
4. Appropriateness to audience

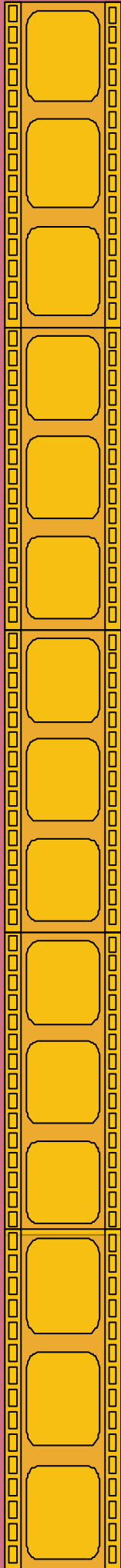
